The Maternal & Child Health Program is carried out by registered nurses who provide medical, social, educational, & other services at no cost to families in Davis County.

## Who is Eligible?

- Families with children ages 0-8
- Pregnant women seeking medical insurance
- Families with barriers to accessing immunizations



## Services Available:

### BABY YOUR BABY

Temporary medical coverage for pregnant women including:

- prenatal visits and lab tests
- ultrasound tests
- ER visits related to pregnancy

### HOME VISITATION PROGRAM

Free and confidential in-home education and one-on-one support including:

- postpartum screenings for parents
- developmental screenings for children
- immunizations for the family on a case by case basis

### REFERRALS TO COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Support accessing services and programs related to food security, employment, housing, education, mental health, immigration & safety through our community referral network.
